

**MINUTES

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen, Town of Delhi, Louisiana, met in regular session on Monday, April 11, 2022. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Washington with an invocation and pledge. The roll was called with the following answering: Mayor Washington, Alderwoman Oliver, Alderman Houston, Alderman Washington and Alderman Whitney. Alderman Rancher made a motion to approve the agenda with and addition of Mr. Jamie Mayo, M5 Consulting to old business second by Alderman Houston. Upon being put to a vote the motion carried. The vote was unanimous.
